** CANDIDATES ARE AUTHORIZED TO BRING HOME STATION TA-50 THAT IS LISTED ON THE PACKING LIST. ANY OTHER TA-50 IS UNAUTHORIZED. **IF A CANDIDATE HAS A SLEEP SYSTEM ON THEIR CLOTHING RECORD, THEY MUST BRING IT TO SFAS, AS FT BRAGG CIF **WILL NOT** ISSUE ONE TO ANY CANDIDATE WITH A SLEEP SYSTEM ALREADY ON THEIR CLOTHING RECORD

** WINTER ITEMS WILL BE MANDATORY FOR ALL CLASSES

** ALL MANDATORY ITEMS AND ADDITIONAL AUTHORIZED ITEMS MUST FIT INTO **(2) DUFFEL BAGS**

1. T-Shirts must be loose fitting cotton, NO TIGHT FITTING, Under Armour or other athletic shirts are not authorized
2. Unauthorized items will be confiscated and placed in hold baggage during initial layout. If items are found during subsequent inspections, that item will be confiscated and student will be released from course.
3. This packing list provides guidance for all classes. Candidates are responsible for having all items before arrival to Fort Bragg and Camp Mackall.
4. Winter items are mandatory for all selection courses.
5. Uniforms must have engineer tape sewn as per SFAS Standard Operating Procedures. An example can be referenced on the SFAS Milsuite site listed at the top of the packing list

THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE UNAUTHORIZED AND ARE GROUNDS FOR RELIEF FROM THE COURSE IF FOUND AFTER THE LAYOUT

1. CELLULAR PHONE/ELECTRONIC ITEMS (THESE WILL BE TURNED IN AND LOCKED UP DURING THE INITIAL LAYOUT)
2. ANY PRODUCT CONTAINING CAFFEINE
3. TOBACCO PRODUCTS OF ANY TYPE
4. CIVILIAN LONG UNDERWEAR
5. CONTACT LENSES
6. MODIFIED SHOULDER STRAPS, OR KIDNEY PADS
7. SPANDEX, ATHLETIC WEAR/UNDERWEAR (i.e. TIGHT FITTING UNDERARMOR)
8. SUPPLEMENTS, VITAMINS, ENERGY PRODUCTS OF ANY TYPE
9. GORETEX OR TEMPERATE WEATHER BOOTS AND SOCKS
10. CIVILIAN MEDICATIONS (I.E. ASPIRIN, TYLENOL)
11. NO MODIFIED OR NON-STANDARD TA 50 (SEE APPROVED TA-50 LIST)
12. NO KINESIOLOGY TAPE
13. NO MEDICAL TAPE, BAND AIDS, WRAPS OR BRACES OF ANY KIND
14. NO CHEM LIGHTS, GLINT/REFLECTIVE TAPE, PT BELTS
15. NO PERSONAL LAND NAVIGATION ITEMS, TOOLS, OR NOTES
